Family Services of Interfaith - Floyd County

- Financial - Housing, Utilities, Medical - assist with prevention of shut off of services
- Food Pantry - provide 3-4 days of food, based on family size
- TARC Tickets - provided free tickets for medical or employment purposes
- ASAP - Seasonal Appliances: Air Conditioners, Fans, Heaters
- Backpack Program - provide backpacks and school supplies to local students
- Clothe-A-Teen - provide \$75 in Back-to-School clothing for teens
- Adopt-A-Family - Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas - Coordinate churches and families to provide food, clothing & gifts
- Operation Santa Claus - provide elementary children two gifts of \$35 each

Family Self-Sufficiency - Floyd County

- Online assistance to register for state and federal aid
- Financial Education Class referrals in partnership with SIABC (Southern Indiana Asset Building Coalition)
- Nutrition Classes in partnership with Purdue Extension Office
- Distribution of important, pertinent information
- Case Management Referral, partnering with other agencies i.e. Homeless Prevention, Impact, etc.
